

PEACE WALK FOR UNITED NATIONS DAY

Peace Walk for United Nations Day, sponsored by Sri Chinmoy: The Peace Meditation at the United Nations in conjunction with a number of Permanent Representatives, took place 29-30 October. Staff and delegates, walking country by country in a marked area of the UN Garden, signed a copy of the Charter as they re-dedicated themselves to its principles. In all, over 70 countries were represented in the Walk.

Mr. Jean Gazarian, Special Advisor, Office for the Commemoration of the Fortieth Anniversary, noted at the final ceremony of the Walk that "Tomorrow in the General Assembly Hall the Secretariat will make a recommitment to the principles of the Charter. Today you have blended the two elements, the delegations and the Secretariat."

Mr. Gazarian presented the Peace Walk with a commemorative medal for the Fortieth Anniversary and a UN flag to hoist at this coming Fall's Peace Walk for United Nations Charter Day.
